KAPPA CHAPTER RULES

I. Name

The name of this chapter shall be Kappa Chapter, Eta State Organization, The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International. *Constitution*, Article I.B

II. Purposes

The purposes of Kappa Chapter shall be the seven Purposes of The Delta Kappa Gamma Society International and those of Eta State Organization, in accordance with The *Constitution*, Article II.

III. Membership

- A. Membership is in accordance with the *Constitution*, Article III; and the *International Standing Rules*, Section 3. The chapter has full authority for the administration of membership.
- B. Membership is classified as active, reserve, and one 'grandfathered' honorary, (Kappa no longer has the honorary classification.) Procedures for electing members is stated.
- C. Recommendation for Membership (Form 11) shall be available at each regular chapter meeting.

- D. Recommendation for Membership (Form 11) shall be completed by the sponsor and returned to the membership chairman by the December meeting.
- E. The Membership Committee shall present the candidates' names to the chapter membership.
- F. Voting for prospective members will occur at the February meeting.
- G. The general membership shall vote by secret ballot. A simple majority will elect the candidate to membership.
- H. Invitations will be sent according to the schedule agreed upon at the Coordinating Council meeting.
- I. Orientation of members-elect shall be held at least 30 days prior to initiation.
- J. The orientation program shall be the responsibility of the membership committee.
- K. Members-elect will indicate in writing, 2 weeks prior to orientation, their acceptance of membership.
- L. Initiation shall be held on a date determined by the Coordinating Council.
- M. The recording secretary shall record in the chapter or executive board meeting minutes the name of any member whose membership is terminated. The record shall include date of termination.
- N. A memorial gift of \$20.00 will be sent to the Eta State Scholarship Fund upon the death of a member.
- O. A memorial gift of \$10.00 will be sent to the Eta State Scholarship Fund upon the death of anyone in a member's immediate family.

- P. The executive board shall decide on the disposition of Society jewelry that has been returned to the chapter.
- Q. Annual reserve dues will be paid by Kappa chapter for members who are diagnosed with advanced dementia.
- R. Members will be given a 20, 30, 40, 50.... year pin as recognition of continuous membership in Kappa and or DKG, purchased by the chapter.

IV. Finances

- A. Financial matters are in accordance with the *Constitution*, Article IV, and the *International Standing Rules*, 4.3 and 4.4, and Eta State Organization Bylaws.
- B. The Finance Committee may make recommendations to the Executive Board for changes in dues no later than January. All members shall be notified prior to the first meeting of the fiscal year.
- C. Proposed changes to chapter dues shall be presented for vote by chapter members at the February meeting.
- D. Annual chapter, state organization and international dues and fees shall be collected by the chapter treasurer prior to October 31 and forwarded to the Eta State Organization treasurer by November 10.
- E. The Finance Committee shall develop an annual budget and present it to the membership for approval at the February meeting.
 - 1. The treasurer shall order the president's pin at the chapter's expense.

2. Budget is to include up to \$500 for the President's expenses to state, regional, and/or international meetings.
 3. Consideration shall be given to allocation of monies for grants-in-aid and/or scholarships.
- F. The annual audit shall be conducted by an ad hoc committee.

V. Organization

- A. Kappa Chapter shall govern the conduct of its business in a manner consistent with the *Constitution*, Article V; the *International Standing Rules*, 6.03; the Eta State Organization Bylaws; the Eta State Organization Standing Rules; and the Kappa Chapter Standing Rules.
- B. Kappa Chapter retains membership in the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Coordinating Council.
- C. Chapter president is a representative on the Eta State Executive Board.

VI. Officers and Related Personnel

- A. Officers and Related Personnel is in accordance with *Constitution*, VI; *International Standing Rules* 6.03.
- B. Kappa Chapter officers shall be president, first vice president, second vice president, secretary (all elected), treasurer (selected by the executive board), and parliamentarian (appointed by the president).

- C. Chapter officers shall be elected to a two-year term in even-numbered years.
- D. A slate of officers, with one nominee per office, shall be prepared by the Nominations Committee and presented to the membership and voted upon at the February meeting, in even numbered years.
- E. If there is but one nominee for an office, the election may be by voice vote.
- F. Officers shall perform duties as specified in the *Constitution*, Article VI; the Eta State Organization Bylaws; and as authorized in the Kappa Chapter Standing Rules.
- G. In addition:
 - 1. The president shall serve as delegate to the Coordinating Council.
 - 2. The first vice-president shall serve as chairman of the Educational Excellence Committee.
 - 3. The second vice-president shall serve on the Coordinating Council.
 - 4. The secretary shall be responsible for recording updated chapter standing rules as policies are changed during business meetings.

VII. Executive Board

- A. The members of Kappa Chapter Executive Board shall be the elected officers, the immediate past president, and committee chairmen. The treasurer is ex officio “with vote” and the parliamentarian is ex officio “without vote.”
- B. The Kappa Chapter Executive Board shall function according to the *Constitution*, VII.

- C. The Executive Board meets at least twice each year, but may meet more often.
- D. The quorum is the majority of the executive board-voting members.

VIII. Committees

- A. Standing committees shall include those for which the chapter has constitutional responsibility:
 - 1. Finance
 - 2. Membership
 - 3. Educational Excellence Committee
 - 4. Communications
 - 5. Scholarship
 - 6. World Fellowship
- B. Kappa Chapter has the following additional standing committees:
 - 1. Social
 - 2. Ways and Means
 - 3. Scrapbook/Historian
- C. Standing committees shall fulfill responsibilities as outlined in the *Constitution*, Article VIII; and the Eta State Standing Rules.
- D. In addition, ad hoc work committees will be appointed as needed.

IX. Meetings

- A. Kappa Chapter, as specified in the *Constitution*, Article IS; *International Standing Rules* 9.0, shall have four business meetings per year, with at least

two additional meetings, and or excursions scheduled.

- B. A quorum shall consist of 15 members.

X. Communication/Publications

- A. Publication shall follow the *Constitution*, Article XII; *International Standing Rules*, Section 12.52.
- B. President approves all publications and electronic messaging.
- C. At least four issues of Kappa Keynotes Newsletter shall be published, via email, per year. Chapter name, Volume number, and Issue number specified.

XI. Parliamentary Authority

Roberts' Rules of Order Newly Revised is designated for the governance of the chapter in all instances in which the authority is not inconsistent with the *Constitution*, Article XV, or other Society Rules.

XII. Amendments

- A. The executive board shall review the Kappa rules at least once during the biennium.
- B. Individual rules changes may be considered at any regular business meeting.
- C. Proposed revisions shall be presented in writing to the membership, in the newsletter.

- D. Revisions shall be voted on at a scheduled business meeting and approved by simple majority.
- E. Kappa Rules shall be included in the yearbook every biennium.
- F. Amendment procedures are reflected in the *Constitution*, Article XVI.

XIII. Dissolution

- A. Approval of the Eta State Executive Board must be obtained before a chapter is dissolved, as specified in the *Constitution*, Article XIX.
- B. Procedure for the transfer of members follows International transfer procedures.
- C. Funds remaining in chapter accounts are to be sent to the Eta State treasurer for state or international projects.
- D. The chapter charter, paraphernalia, and records shall be delivered to the Eta State Organization.
- E. The Eta State Executive Board shall decide whether the Greek name shall be retired or reused.
