Kappans met at the new offices of International House, Charlotte (IH) on February 10, 2024 to tour the spacious center which serves immigrants in the Charlotte area. IH is a resource center for housing and childcare, open Monday-Thursday 9-5 with no appointment needed. IH provides English language instruction as well as outreach to seven CMS elementary schools for after-school tutoring. IH assists immigrants with career coaching, Green Card applications, citizenship preparation, work permits and rejoining family members already in Charlotte. IH has been host to international visitors in cooperation with the U.S. State Department, including a future Prime Minister. Many thanks to Lauren Rogers for hosting our meeting and reminding us once again of the needs of immigrants in our community.

## **Tech Tidbits**Phone Battery Tip

There are a lot of tips on how to extend battery life on your phone. The problem is that you also want to retain the functionality of your device. A frequent suggestion is to disable background app refresh. Background app refresh allows the phone to update content in the background whether you are using it or not. This increases battery usage and slows down performance. To turn this off on an iPhone (there is a similar setting on android phones):

- Go to Settings and tap on General
- Tap on Background App Refresh
- Toggle the switch to Off.

This will turn off app refreshing for all apps, which I suggest you do. All apps will still work perfectly fine, they will only refresh when you open them. Alternatively, you can leave the toggle on and select specific apps to not refresh. All installed apps will be listed alphabetically below the initial toggle switch. If you take this option, keep your selections to a minimum. Stats indicate that the average user has 80 apps on their phone and consistently uses less than 10.
